The only difference is that Molecular Nutrition owns the patent on arachidonic acid which is in X-factor and Syntrax is violating that patent by selling Hyper-H. Another little detail is one of quality. The quality of the X-Factor caplets and ingredients is higher.*

Yeah, if you do decide to use AA (which it sounds like you already have) go with X-factor. Supporting Syntrax's shady business practices is not the way to go. It has been mentioned that although the Syntrax product is cheaper, you get more of the X-factor so the price per gram is similar in most cases, if not the same. Then there are the quality issues, patent issues, rep issues, etc.

Remember, buying Syntrax is not yet a ban worthy offense, but hopefully it will be someday.
