





The wording in the 2000 Stud Book says, "Purchasers of the Stud Book may generate their own pedigree records and charts and pass these on with any dog that they sell. However, the generation of pedigree charts for sale or publication is controlled by the Society's rights of information ownership".

Anyone involved in producing pedigrees for sale can be issued a simple annual licence and will be able to endorse all charts with this statement. We are happy to assist this 'cottage industry' :-

If you purchase pedigree charts it will be helpful if you ask and check that the licensing statement has been applied.
